Maybe you do not know the Bible's definition

of a religious hypocrite. The Bible describes:

In *Ecclesiastes 5 and Matthew 23* that a hypo-

crites makes vows and promises to God but does not

keep them.

In *Jeremiah 7* a hypocrite is proud of his

church attendance or membership but his heart and

mind are not sincere and right in God's eyes.

In *Matthew 7*, a hypocrite negatively criticizes

and condemns other people for their sins while he

ignores and denies his own sins and does not stop.

In *Matthew 23*, a hypocrite makes a nice pub-

lic show of being very religious but his heart is not

in it. He proudly tries to impress people to think

that he is so spiritually wonderful, but really he is a

sinner too like them, and in need of God and an in-

imate relationship with Jesus Christ.

Considering these Bible descriptions, are you a

Christian church hypocrite? Some times I am.

Victory over being a Christian religious hypo-

crites is possible through powerful intimate relat-

ionship with God and Christ (*John 15:1-16*).

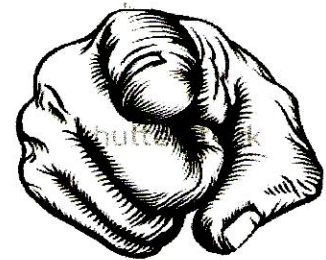
Romans 10:9 tells us:

I have been a sincere Christian and church
attender for many years, in different countries. I
also am a sinner saved and forgiven by grace from
God (*Ephesians 2:8-9*). Some times I have been told
by a person that they do not attend Christian
church, and do not want to attend, because the
church is full of hypocrites. Do you agree? Is their
complaint true? Or is it only a lazy excuse?
I think the correct answer is both. Christian
churches can be full of religious hypocrites, be-
cause ALL people are imperfect and sinners (*Rom-
ans 3:23*). Simply being a Christian does not make
you perfect without sin (*Romans 7*). It is also true
that some people just make excuses to avoid God
and church. They are not sincere or honest.
If you are a Christian, are you one of the reli-
gious hypocrites who attends church? I admit, some
times I have been a religious hypocrite by the
Bible's definition. But part of victory over being a
Christian religious hypocrite is to recognize how
you are one, and admit it, and ask for forgiveness
from the Lord Jesus Christ who is our only Savior
