Jesus prayed: “Father, . . . Glorify Your Son so he can give glory back to You. For You have given him authority over everyone. He gives eternal life to each one You have given him. This is the way to have eternal life-- to know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, the one You sent to earth” (*John 17:1-3*). I want to share in GOD’s eternal life through Jesus Christ, God’s Son. I want YOU to share that true life too. So please now yield to GOD’s salvation for you through the Lord Jesus Christ. Driver, please yield to Christ now, to avoid eternal spiritual vehicle tragedy!

Please take time to pray right now!

First, admit honestly to the Lord that you are a sinner and need His help (*Romans 3:23; 6:23*).

Second, tell the Lord you believe in Him and want to share in His eternal life and forgiveness of sins through Jesus Christ (*John 3:16; 1 John 1:9*).

Then tell Lord Jesus you believe in Him, His death on the cross for you, and His resurrection to new life to share with you (*1 Corinthians 15:3-4*).

Next ask the Lord Jesus to live in your heart and life by the Spirit of GOD, and to save your life and save your soul by GOD’s grace and mercy (*Galatians 2:20; Ephesians 2:8-9*).

Fifth, ask GOD to make you strong, firm, and dedicated to a successful new life with His guidance (*Psalms 27:11; 86:11; 139:23-24*).

End your prayer by thanking GOD and the Lord Jesus for saving your life and your soul and forgiving your sins. Thank GOD for giving you strong faith in Him and faith in what you have asked Him here to do (*1 Corinthians 15:57*).
